RESURRECTION CEMETERY

RULES GOVERNING MONUMENTS AND MARKERS

- 1. No monument or marker will be accepted for installation unless the gravesite is paid for and is accompanied by a permit, in writing, signed by the Cemetery Supervision and a check covering the cost of installation. The check must be delivered to the Cemetery Office located at the Victoria Diocese Chancery, P. O. Box 4070, 1505 E. Mesquite Lane, Victoria, Texas 77903. The markers and monuments must be delivered to the cemetery at 1009 E. Mockingbird Lane, Victoria, Texas 77904.**
- 2. Application for such permit is to be made on the form provided by the cemetery.**
- 3. All monuments and markers must be granite or bronze affixed to granite.**
- 4. Monuments or ground-level markers are regulated as follows:
Cemeteries #1, 2 and 3: Monuments or ground-level markers are permitted.
Resurrection Cemetery: Monuments or ground-level markers are permitted in Lots A, C, E, G, I, L, M of Block One, Lots A and D of Block Two and all of Blocks A, B, 7, 8 and 9. In all other areas only ground-level markers are permitted.**
- 5. All ground-level markers must be cored for and fitted with a vase of corrosion resistant material. All monuments must have a vase of granite or bronze permanently attached to the base. Two such vases are permitted. Only infant markers may have the glued-on half-circle cone-shaped vase, but that side of the granite must be smooth. No glass or plastic vases are allowed.**
- 6. The maximum permissible size marker is: Single - 20" x 30", Double - 20" x 60", Triple – 20" x 78" x 6" (triple must be 6")
The maximum permissible size of monuments is:
Single - Base: 42" long, 16" wide, 6" high; Die: 30" long, 8" wide (slants 10" wide), 24" high
Double - Base: 66" long, 16" wide, 6" high; Die: 54" long, 8" wide (slants 10" wide), 24" high
Triple - Base: 78" long, 16" wide, 6" high; Die: 56" long, 8" wide (slants 10" wide), 24" high
The length, width and height may be less but not more than these specifications.**
- 7. All lettering and design must be carved into the granite or on a bronze plaque permanently affixed to the granite.**
- 8. All monuments and markers shall be delivered to the gravesite by the dealer or purchaser and will be set by cemetery personnel. Setting fees shall be delivered to the Cemetery Office, at the Chancery Building, 1505 E. Mesquite Lane, Victoria. Mailing address is; Victoria Catholic Cemeteries, P. O. Box 4070, Victoria, Texas 77903.**
- 9. Veteran's bronze markers must be mounted to a granite base and if it is not a part of a double marker where a vase is mounted, than the granite base must be drilled to accommodate a vase.**
- 10. Slant monuments are allowed but must be set on a base and have at least one vase.**

NO EXCEPTION WILL BE MADE TO ANY OF THESE RULES FOR ANY REASON.

Dear Monument Company Representative,

Please use the new form from this date forward. I have added the family contact information right below the monument company information. If there is a problem, i.e. plot not paid in full, wrong dates, can't find the deceased in the database, etc., then I can contact them directly. Also in the future, if something happens to the monument, damage or whatever, I have the family contact information in the database and I don't have to bother you.

Also take note of rule #10 on the "RULES GOVERNING MONUMENTS AND MARKERS" page. Slant monuments are now allowed BUT must be set on a base and still must have at least one vase. Slant monuments are usually 10" from front to back at the base, so I have increased the maximum width allowed on the base to 16".

Also, I have added a sentence to rule #5. Only infant markers may have the glued-on half-circle cone-shaped vase, but that side of the granite must be smooth. This is really not a change but some people did not know we were allowing the glued-on vases. Again, it is only allowed on the infant markers.
